Philippians 2.1-11

'If then there is any encouragement in Christ, any consolation from love, any sharing in the Spirit, any compassion and sympathy, make my joy complete: be of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves. Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others. Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus,

who, though he was in the form of God,
did not regard equality with God
as something to be **exploited**, ('grasped', 'taken advantage of')
but emptied himself,
taking the form of a slave, ('servant')
being born in human likeness.



Earth Overshoot Day falls on 1 August this year - marking the point at which consumption exceeds the capacity of nature to regenerate






Between 1970 and 2018 Latin America and the Caribbean had the steepest decline in biodiversity Index 1970=1


